Subj: RENAMING OF COMMANDING OFFICER, HELICOPTER ANTISUBMARINE SQUADRON FIVE (HS-5)

Ref: (a) OPNAVINST 5400.44A of 13 Oct 2011

1. Purpose. To approve renaming of subject fleet activity per reference (a).
2. Background. In support of the Naval Aviation Helicopter Concept of Operations, HS-5, an active duty operational squadron flying the SH-60F and HH-60H type-model-series will be renamed to reflect the new community designations and will fly the MH-60S type-model-series.
3. Organizational Changes.
 - a. Effective 15 April 2013, change the name and mission of HS-5. The following applies:

b. Revised Mission. Operate and support an eight-plane MH-60S HSC squadron on aircraft carriers. Be prepared to simultaneously operate on the aircraft carrier and provide one two-plane detachment to carrier strike group based supply ship. Additionally, be capable of providing a one-plane or a two-plane detachment to air-capable ships or land bases. The detachment shall be CSAR and NSW capable (but not concurrently). Projected deployment cycle is per the current Fleet Response Plan (FRP).
