Subj: DISESTABLISHMENT OF COMMANDING OFFICER, NAVAL MOBILE
CONSTRUCTION BATTALION (NMCB) FIFTEEN AND NMCB TWO EIGHT

1. Purpose. To approve disestablishment of subject fleet activities per reference (a).

2. Background. To comply with the Congressional Budget Act of 2011, the Department of Defense conducted a comprehensive Alternative Program Objectives Memorandum for Fiscal Year 2013, with a mandate to reduce federal spending to include a decrease in forces. Navy programmed two reserve battalions assigned to U.S. Pacific Fleet, NMCB-15 and NMCB-28, for disestablishment as part of the President's Budget for FY13.

3. Organizational Changes.

a. Effective 30 September 2013, disestablish NMCB-15. The following applies:

4. Action

a. Commander, U.S. Pacific Fleet / Commander, First Naval Construction Division Pacific / Commander, NINTH Naval Construction Regiment will take appropriate action to disestablish NMCB-15 and NMCB-28.

b. This is advance change 45-12 to reference (b).

c. Master Update Authority, Honolulu, HI will delete the Plain Language Addresses (PLAs) in the Central Directory Component for NMCB-15 and NMCB-28 effective 30 September 2013 and 30 September 2014 respectively unless otherwise directed via official correspondence. d. Director, Navy Staff Organization and Management Branch (DNS-33) will revise reference (b).

5. Cancellation Contingency. This notice will remain in effect for one year or until superseded, whichever occurs first. The organization action will remain effective until changed by Director, Navy Staff.
