Subj: ACQUISITION OF CRUISE BOOKS AND UNIT YEARBOOKS OF NAVY
AND MARINE CORPS UNITS

1. Purpose. To request all ships, stations, and Marine Corps Units make available copies of published cruise books and unit histories or information concerning the publishing of such items, to the Navy Department, in order to enable the Department to assemble a comprehensive reference source of such historical information.

2. Cancellation. OPNAVINST 5070.1B.

3. Background. There is considerable historic data contained in the cruise books and unit histories published by various commands. Since these materials are generally published and paid for privately, there has been no comprehensive reference collection or bibliography, and the historic value of these publications has not been fully exploited.
