Subj: ESTABLISHMENT OF EXPEDITIONARY MEDICAL FACILITY DALLAS ONE, FORT WORTH, TX AND EXPEDITIONARY MEDICAL FACILITY GREAT LAKES ONE, GREAT LAKES, IL

1. Purpose. To approve establishment of Expeditionary Medical Facility Dallas One (EMF DALLAS ONE) and Expeditionary Medical Facility Great Lakes One (EMF GREAT LAKES ONE) per reference (a).

2. Background. This Bureau of Medicine and Surgery (BUMED) action establishes two expeditionary medical facilities to provide medical and dental services across the full range of military operations when called to support a combatant commander. The units perform a role similar to the former reserve fleet hospitals and are composed of an active component supported by approximately 500 selective reserve medical personnel.

3. Organizational Changes. Establish EMF DALLAS ONE and EMF GREAT LAKES ONE fleet commands effective 1 January 2013. The following applies:


4. Action

a. Chief, BUMED will take appropriate action to establish
EMF DALLAS ONE and EMF GREAT LAKES ONE fleet activities.

b. Master Update Authority, Honolulu, HI will add the PLAs in the Central Directory Component effective 1 October 2012 unless otherwise directed via official correspondence. Correspondence concerning the PLAs should be forwarded to Naval Network Warfare Command (NAVNETWARCOM) (Network Operations 321), Bldg 1265, Joint Expeditionary Base Little Creek Fort Story, Virginia Beach, VA 23459-5000 or by calling (757) 322-1149/1150. New commands should be activated on Navy Regional Enterprise Message System (NREMS).
