Subj: DISESTABLISH NAVSUP LOGISTICS OPERATIONS CENTER, NORFOLK, VA, AND CONSOLIDATE FUNCTIONS INTO AND MODIFY MISSION OF NAVSUP GLOBAL LOGISTICS SUPPORT, SAN DIEGO, CA

1. Purpose. To implement Secretary of the Navy approval to disestablish subject shore activity, and to issue CNO approval of the mission modification of subject shore activity per reference (a).

2. Background. The disestablishment of NAVSUP Logistics Operations Center (NAVSUP LOG OPS CEN), Norfolk, VA and consolidation of its mission with NAVSUP Global Logistics Support (NAVSUP GLOBAL LOG SPT), San Diego, CA is designed to consolidate all NAVSUP operational logistics functions under a single echelon 3 command. A NAVSUP GLOBAL LOG SPT support site will be maintained at the site of the disestablished Norfolk command, using the existing UIC of the former command.

3. Organizational Changes. Disestablish NAVSUP LOG OPS CEN and modify mission of NAVSUP GLOBAL LOG SPT effective 1 October 2012. The following applies:

b. Mission Modification. NAVSUP GLOBAL LOG SPT modified mission will be:

To function as Commander, Naval Supply Systems Command's (NAVSUP) global provider of integrated supply and support services to the fleet, expeditionary and shore activities; to partner with other Navy and DoD providers to improve efficiency and affordability, delivering coordinated operational logistics support to Naval forces; to interface with Systems Commands, Fleet/Type commanders, Commander, Naval Installations Command and Regional Commanders to formulate common policy and procedures across all Fleet Logistics Centers and perform other functions as may be directed by NAVSUP.

4. Action

a. Commander, Naval Supply Systems Command will take appropriate action to disestablish subject shore activity and issue, in accordance with reference (a), a revised Mission, Functions and Tasks Directive for the merged activity.

b. Master Update Authority, Honolulu, HI will delete the PLA in the Central Directory Component effective 1 October 2012 unless otherwise directed via official correspondence.
