Subj: DISESTABLISHMENT OF COMMANDING OFFICER, FLEET IMAGING COMMAND PACIFIC (FLTIMAGCOMPAC) AND OFFICER IN CHARGE FLEET IMAGING CENTER PACIFIC (FLTIMAGCENPAC) GUAM; AND MODIFICATION OF OFFICER IN CHARGE, FLEET COMBAT CAMERA GROUP PACIFIC (FLTCOMBATCAMGRUPAC)

1. Purpose. To approve the disestablishment of FLTIMAGCOMPAC and FLTIMAGCENPAC Guam, and modification of FLTCOMBATCAMGRUPAC per reference (a).

2. Background.

a. SECDEF directed the Services to conduct a comprehensive Fiscal Year 2012 Program Objectives Memorandum Efficiency Review to improve the Department's overall combat / combat support capability and to reduce the total cost of ownership. As part of the Navy's POM-12, Fleet Imaging Command Pacific will be disestablished. Fleet Imaging Command Pacific served as the parent command for Combat Camera (operational video teams) and Fleet Imaging Centers (shore video teams).

b. Due to the disestablishment of Fleet Imaging Command Pacific, Combat Camera will take over as the parent activity to oversight the Visual Information community and continue to deploy Combat Camera teams in support of Pacific Fleet tasking.

c. Fleet Imaging Centers were disestablished in 2005 and the shore mission was transferred to Public Affairs Centers which included the activity in Guam. This is an administrative action to remove FLTIMAGCENPAC GUAM from the SNDL and other Navy databases since the billets were removed at the end of FY05.

3. Organizational Change.

c. Revised Mission. Provide Commander, U.S. Pacific Fleet a Combat Documentation (COMDOC) capability to all combat-ready forces in naval, joint and combined operations in support of U.S. Pacific Command or other Unified Combatant Commanders as directed by SECDEF. Maintain, train, and equip Combat Camera teams to a state of operational readiness prepared to respond to rapid deployment tasking in order to provide fleet and combatant commanders with specialized imaging capabilities for the attainment of naval and national objectives.

4. Action.

a. Commander, U.S. Pacific Fleet / Commander, Naval Air Force, U.S. Pacific Fleet will take appropriate action per reference (a) to disestablish Fleet Imaging Command Pacific and Fleet Imaging Center Pacific Guam. Direct and coordinate the modification of Fleet Combat Camera Group Pacific led by a Detachment Officer-in-Charge into Fleet Combat Camera Pacific to be led by a Commanding Officer. Ensure the command's Combat Camera Teams are deployable, fully trained, properly manned, capably equipped, well maintained, and sustainable to meet the mission requirements listed in reference (b) (Required Operational Capabilities (ROC) and Projected Operational Environment (POE) for Combat Camera Teams.

b. This is advance change 43-12 to reference (c).

c. Master Update Authority, Honolulu, HI will delete the Plain Language Addresses (PLAs) in the Central Directory Component for Fleet Imaging Command Pacific and Fleet Imaging Center Pacific Guam and modify the PLA for Fleet Combat Camera Pacific effective 30 September 2012 unless otherwise directed via official correspondence. d. Director, Navy Staff Organization and Management Branch (DNS-33) will revise reference (c).

5. Cancellation Contingency. This notice will remain in effect for one year or until superseded, whichever occurs first. The organization action will remain effective until changed by Director, Navy Staff.
