Subj: ESTABLISHMENT OF OFFICER IN CHARGE OF CONSTRUCTION MARINE
CORPS MARIANAS, GUAM MARIANAS

Ref: (a) OPNAVINST 5400.44A
(b) OPNAVINST 5400.45

1. Purpose. To implement Secretary of the Navy (SECNAV) approval to establish Officer in Charge of Construction Marine Corps Marianas (OICC MARINE CORPS MARIANAS) shore activity, per reference (a).

2. Background. Establishment of the OICC MARINE CORPS MARIANAS allows Naval Facilities Engineering Command (NAVFACENGCOM) to establish a single accountable command to coordinate facilities engineering and acquisition efforts to manage the planning, design, and construction of over \$8.7 billion in projects related to the relocation of Marine Corps units from Okinawa to Guam.

3. Organizational Changes. Effective 1 March 2016, establish OICC MARINE CORPS MARIANAS. The following applies:

(1) Objective: To provide best-value facilities engineering and acquisition services for the Navy-Marine Corps team in support of the Defense Policy Review Initiative to relocate Marines and related training activities from Okinawa to Guam and the Mariana Islands.

(2) Area Coordination: Commander, Navy Installations Command.

(3) Regional Coordination: Commander, Joint Region Marianas.

(4) Budget Submitting Office: NAVFACENGCOM.

(5) OPNAV Resources Sponsor: Deputy Chief of Naval Operations for Fleet Readiness and Logistics (CNO (N4)).

4. Action

a. Commander, NAVFACENGCOM will take appropriate action, consistent with reference (a), to establish subject shore activity and to issue a mission, functions and task directive for the new command within 90 days of such establishment. Distribution of this directive will include Director, Navy Staff.


b. Master Update Authority, Honolulu, HI will add the PLA in the Central Directory Component via messaging systems effective immediately upon Commander, NAVFACENGCOM and Commanding Officer, NAVFACENGCOM Marianas request to Commander, Naval Network Warfare Command (COMNAVNETWARCOM) (NetOps 321), 112 Lake View Pkwy, Suffolk, VA 23435-2696, via email at C20IX_Reg@navy.mil or by calling (757) 203-0338/0339. New PLA

will be activated via messaging systems. Additional information on naval messaging can be obtained at <https://sailor.nmci.navy.smil.mil> or by contacting COMNAVNETWARCOM at numbers in this subparagraph. (New direction - NAVFACENGCOM and NAVFACENGCOM Marianas ACTION REQUIRED regarding the PLA).

c. Director, Navy Staff Organization and Management Branch (DNS-33) will revise reference (b).

5. Records Management. Records created as a result of this notice, regardless of media or format, must be managed per SECNAV Manual 5210.1 of January 2012.

6. Cancellation Contingency. This notice will remain in effect for 1 year or until superseded, whichever occurs first. The organization action will remain effective until changed by Director, Navy Staff.
