Subj: RENAME NAVAL SPECIAL WARFARE SUPPORT ACTIVITY ONE AND  
NAVAL SPECIAL WARFARE SUPPORT ACTIVITY TWO

Ref: (a) OPNAVINST 5400.44A  
(b) OPNAVINST 5400.45

1. Purpose. To modify the name Naval Special Warfare Support Activity (NAVSPECWARSPTACT) ONE and NAVSPECWARSPTACT TWO, per reference (a).

2. Background. Due to recent challenges in recruiting U.S. Navy sea-air-land (SEAL) and special warfare combatant-craft crewmen, Commander, Naval Special Warfare Command (COMNAVSPECWARCOM) is choosing to rename NAVSPECWARSPTACT to Special Reconnaissance Team (SPECRECON TEAM). This name change will more accurately reflect the mission of a non-traditional operational command and enhance recruiting for these critical rates.

3. Organizational Changes. Effective 1 December 2014, rename NAVSPECWARSPTACT ONE and NAVSPECWARSPTACT TWO. The following applies:

4. Action


a. COMNAVSPECWARCOM and Commander, Naval Special Warfare Group TEN shall take appropriate action to rename NAVSPECWARSPTACT ONE and NAVSPECWARSPTACT TWO. Ensure SPECRECON TEAM ONE and SPECRECON TEAM TWO are deployable, properly manned, fully trained, capably equipped, interoperable, well maintained, and combat-sustainable as an operational command to meet the mission requirements, the required operational capabilities, and projected operational environment for expeditionary units.

b. Master Update Authority, Honolulu, HI will revise the PLA in the Central Directory Component via messaging systems effective immediately upon COMNAVSPECWARCOM request to Commander, Naval Network Warfare Command (COMNAVNETWARCOM) (Network Operations 321), 112 Lake View Pkwy, Suffolk, VA 23435-2696 or by calling (757) 203-0338/0339. Revised PLA will be activated via messaging systems. (New direction - COMNAVSPECWARCOM action required regarding the PLA.)

c. This is advance change 02-15 to reference (b).

5. Records Management. Records created as a result of this notice, regardless of media or format, shall be managed per Secretary of the Navy Manual 5210.1 of January 2012.

6. Cancellation Contingency. This notice will remain in effect for 1 year or until superseded, whichever occurs first. The organization action will remain effective until changed by Director, Navy Staff.
