Subj: DISESTABLISH PATROL COASTAL MAINTENANCE SUPPORT TEAM TWO,  
FOUR, AND SIX

Ref: (a) OPNAVINST 5400.44A  
(b) OPNAVINST 5400.45

1. Purpose. To disestablish Patrol Coastal Maintenance Support Teams (PCMSUPPTM) TWO, FOUR, and SIX, per reference (a).

2. Background. Commander, Naval Surface Forces Atlantic (COMNAVSURFLANT) shall disestablish PCMSUPPTMs TWO, FOUR, and SIX. With the relocation and redistribution of patrol coastal (PC) assets, the responsibility of PC maintenance has been absorbed into Patrol Coastal Squadron ONE (PCRON ONE) for Bahrain based PCs and Destroyer Squadron FOURTEEN (DESRON FOURTEEN) for Mayport, FL based PCs.

3. Organizational Changes. Disestablish PCCMSUPPTMs TWO, FOUR, and SIX effective immediately. The following applies:

#### 4. Action

a. Commander, U.S. Fleet Forces Command and COMNAVSURFLANT shall take appropriate action to disestablish PCMSUPPTMs TWO, FOUR, and SIX. Manpower previously associated with PCMSUPPTM FOUR has been realigned within PCRON ONE and DESRON FOURTEEN. PCMSUPPTM TWO and PCMSUPPTM SIX manpower have been realigned to DESRON FOURTEEN and PCRON ONE respectively. The UIC for PCMSUPPTM TWO and PCMSUPPTM SIX shall remain a component UIC under DESRON FOURTEEN and PCRON ONE respectively.


b. Master Update Authority, Honolulu, HI will delete the PLAs in the Central Directory Component and disestablish the PCMSUPPTM TWO, FOUR, and SIX PLAs via messaging systems effective immediately upon COMNAVSURFLANT request to Commander, Naval Network Warfare Command (COMNAVNETWARCOM) (Network Operations 321), 112 Lake View Parkway, Suffolk, VA 23435-2696 or via email at C2OIX\_Reg@navy.mil or by calling (757) 203-0338/0339. Disestablished commands will be deactivated via messaging systems. (New direction - COMNAVSURFLANT ACTION REQUIRED regarding the PLA.)

c. This is change 05-15 to reference (b).
