Subj: ESTABLISHMENT OF U.S. AEGIS ASHORE MISSILE DEFENSE SYSTEM
POLAND, REDZIKOWO, POLAND AND DETACHMENT DAM NECK, VA

1. Purpose. To implement Secretary of the Navy approval of the establishment of U.S. Aegis Ashore Missile Defense System Poland (USAAMDS-PL), Redzikowo, Poland, per reference (a).

2. Background. This establishment action is per the U.S.-Poland Ballistic Missile Defense Agreement signed in August 2008. The site at Redzikowo, Poland will be part of and support the European phased adaptive approach for the missile defense of Europe. Funding for the billets for the activity is provided in Program Objective Memorandum-16.

3. Organizational Changes. Effective immediately, establish USAAMDS-PL. The following applies:

4. Action


a. COMUSFLTFORCOM/COMNAVSURFLANT will take appropriate action, per reference (a), to establish the command and detachment as outlined above.

b. Master Update Authority, Honolulu, HI will add the PLAs in the Central Directory Component via messaging systems effective immediately upon COMUSFLTFORCOM/COMNAVSURFLANT request to Commander, Naval Network Warfare Command (COMNAVNETWARCOM) (Network Operations 321), 112 Lake View Pkwy, Suffolk, VA 23435-2696, via email at C2OIX_Reg@navy.mil or by calling (757) 203-0338/0339.
