Subj: PERMANENT DUTY STATION CHANGE FOR PATROL SQUADRON FOUR SEVEN AND PATROL AND RECONNAISSANCE GROUP PACIFIC, DISESTABLISHMENT OF PATROL AND RECONNAISSANCE WING TWO, AND IMMEDIATE SUPERIOR IN COMMAND CHANGE FOR PATROL SQUADRON FOUR, PATROL SQUADRON NINE, PATROL SQUADRON FOUR SEVEN, SPECIAL PROJECTS PATROL SQUADRON TWO AND TACTICAL OPERATIONS CENTER KANOEHE BAY

1. Purpose. To implement Secretary of the Navy (SECNAV) approval for a permanent duty station (PDS) change for Patrol Squadron Four Seven (VP-47) and to approve the PDS change for Patrol and Reconnaissance Group Pacific (PATRECONGRUPAC), the disestablishment of Patrol and Reconnaissance Wing Two (PATRECONWING TWO), and the immediate superior in command (ISIC) change for Patrol Squadron Four (VP-4), Patrol Squadron Nine (VP-9), VP-47, Special Projects Patrol Squadron Two (VPU-2) and Tactical Operations Center (TOC) Kaneohe Bay.

2. Background. VP-47 will change PDS from Marine Corps Air Station Kaneohe Bay, HI to Naval Air Station Whidbey Island, Oak Harbor, WA in order to commence squadron transition from the P-3C aircraft to the P-8A aircraft per the Navy Strategic Laydown and Dispersal Plan 2016 (SLD 16) and Master Aviation Plan (MAP) 15-2. PATRECONGRUPAC will change its PDS from Kaneohe Bay, HI to Whidbey Island, WA in support of the single site and homebasing of the Pacific maritime patrol and reconnaissance community at Whidbey Island. PATRECONWING TWO will disestablish and transfer administrative control of its VP squadrons and TOC to Patrol and Reconnaissance Wing Ten (PATRECONWING TEN).

3. Organizational Changes. Effective on dates shown, modify patrol and reconnaissance units at Kaneohe Bay as follows:

a. Effective 1 Feb 2017, relocate Commander, Patrol and Reconnaissance Group Pacific (COMPATRECONGRUPAC).

d. Modify ISIC assignments for commands under COMPATRECONWING TWO as follows:

(1) VP-4 from COMPATRECONWING TWO to COMPATRECONWING TEN effective immediately.

(2) VP-47 from COMPATRECONWING TWO to COMPATRECONWING TEN effective 1 Sep 2016.

(3) VP-9 from COMPATRECONWING TWO to COMPATRECONWING TEN effective 1 May 2017.

(4) VPU-2 from COMPATRECONWING TWO to COMPATRECONWING TEN effective 1 May 2017.

(5) TOC Kaneohe Bay from COMPATECONWING TWO to COMPATRECONWING TEN effective 1 May 2017.

e. Transfer component UICs (not listed in the SNDL) under COMPATRECONWING TWO to the parent commands in subparagraphs 3e(1) through 3e(3) effective 1 May 2017:

(1) Re-align UIC 32917, Pacific Reconnaissance Operations Center Detachment Hickam, under Commander, U.S. Pacific Fleet (COMPACFLT) (00070). This detachment's mission is part of a joint requirement to directly support intelligence, surveillance, and reconnaissance mission in the United States Pacific Command area of responsibility.

(2) Re-align UIC 44312, Aircraft Intermediate Maintenance Department Kaneohe, under COMPATRECONWING TEN (55165). This detachment provides I-level aircraft maintenance support to Navy squadrons based at Kaneohe.

(3) Re-align UIC 32405, Navy Support Detachment Kaneohe, under COMPATRECONWING TEN (55165). This detachment provides administrative support to Navy squadrons based at Kaneohe.

f. Revised Administrative Chain of Command. Upon completion of all realignments, Pacific Fleet patrol and reconnaissance forces administrative control will be as follows:

4. Action

a. COMPACFLT will take appropriate action to consolidate the Pacific maritime patrol and reconnaissance wings from two to one by transferring mission responsibilities and required assets from COMPATRECONWING TWO to COMPATRECONWING TEN, followed by the disestablishment of COMPATRECONWING TWO. Execute unit relocation, ISIC changes, and re-align component UICs as listed in paragraph 3.

b. COMPACFLT will notify Director, Navy Staff Organization and Management Branch (DNS-33) at the earliest opportunity if a civilian reduction in force is required.

c. Master Update Authority, Honolulu, HI will revise and delete the PLAs in the Central Directory Component via messaging systems effective immediately upon COMPATRECONGRUPAC request to Commander, Naval Network Warfare Command (COMNAVNETWARCOM) (Network Operations 321), 112 Lake View Pkwy, Suffolk, VA 23435-2696, via email at C2OIX_Reg@navy.mil or by calling (757) 203-0338/0339. Revised and deleted PLA notifications will be made via messaging systems. d. This is advance change 18-16 to reference (b).

e. DNS-33 will update reference (b) to reflect the organization changes directed in this notice.
