Subj: MODIFY MISSION FOR NAVAL SPECIAL WARFARE GROUP ELEVEN,
SAN DIEGO, CA

Ref: (a) OPNAVINST 5400.44A

1. Purpose. To approve mission modification for Naval Special Warfare Group (NAVSPECWARGRU) ELEVEN, per reference (a).
2. Background. This mission modification is designed to focus the Naval Special Warfare Reserve component (NAVSPECWARGRU) on providing full operational capability in support of naval special warfare and combatant commanders.
3. Organizational Changes. Effective immediately, modify the mission for NAVSPECWARGRU ELEVEN, San Diego, CA as follows:

NAVSPECWARGRU ELEVEN mission: To organize, man, train, equip, deploy, and sustain Naval Special Warfare Reserve force in the best possible state of readiness to deliver strategic depth and operational capability in support of naval special warfare and combatant commanders.

4. Action
 - a. Commander, Naval Special Warfare Command will take appropriate action, consistent with reference (a), to modify the mission statement of NAVSPECWARGRU ELEVEN.
 - b. Director, Navy Staff Organization and Management Branch (DNS-33) will ensure that a copy of the modified command mission is placed in the master file of the command.
5. Records Management. Records created as a result of this notice, regardless of media or format, must be managed per Secretary of the Navy Manual 5210.1 of January 2012.

6. Cancellation Contingency. This notice will remain in effect for 1 year or until superseded, whichever occurs first. The organization action will remain effective until changed by Director, Navy Staff.
