Subj: MODIFY IMMEDIATE SUPERIOR IN COMMAND FOR UNITED STATES SHIP TORTUGA, UNITED STATES SHIP CARTER HALL

Ref: (a) OPNAVINST 5400.44A
(b) OPNAVINST 5400.45

1. Purpose. To approve the modification of immediate superior in command (ISIC) for United States Ship (USS) Tortuga and USS Carter Hall, per reference (a).

2. Background. This action realigns the administrative reporting relationship of the dock landing ships (LSD) from Commander, Amphibious Squadron FOUR to Commander, Amphibious Squadron SIX for USS Carter Hall and from Commander, Amphibious Squadron EIGHT to Commander, Amphibious Squadron SIX for USS Tortuga. These actions support Task Force Eight Zero Task Organization. There are no changes to current manpower, funding, or location involved with the modification. All commands involved remain under the command of Commander, U.S. Fleet Forces Command. The ISIC change for USS Tortuga will be effective 1 May 2015 through 30 November 2015.

3. Organizational Changes. Modify reporting relationship for USS Tortuga and USS Carter Hall effective immediately. The following applies:

- 5 Commanding Officer, USS Carter Hall (LSD 50) (21880)


4. Action

a. Commander, U.S. Fleet Forces Command shall take appropriate action to effect the modification of reporting relationships for the LSDs.

b. This is advance change 33-15 to reference (b).

5. Records Management. Records created as a result of this notice, regardless of media or format, shall be managed per Secretary of the Navy Manual 5210.1 of January 2012.

6. Cancellation Contingency. This notice will remain in effect for 1 year or until superseded, whichever occurs first. The organization action will remain effective until changed by Director, Navy Staff.
