Subj: ESTABLISHMENT OF FLEET WEATHER CENTER STRIKE DETACHMENT,
FALLON, NV

Ref: (a) OPNAVINST 5400.44A
(b) OPNAVINST 5400.45

1. Purpose. To approve establishment of Fleet Weather Center Strike Detachment (FLEWEACEN STRIKE DET), Fallon, NV, per reference (a).
2. Background. This notice approves the request of Commander, U.S. Fleet Forces Command (COMUSFLTFORCOM) to change an existing component at Fallon of Fleet Weather Center, San Diego, CA into a formally established detachment. This will confer on the Officer in Charge, FLEWEACEN STRIKE DET the authority required to maintain good order and discipline and operational and administrative control of the unit since the parent activity is 700 miles distant.
3. Organizational Changes. Effective immediately, establish FLTWEACEN STRIKE DET at Fallon, NV. The following applies:

4. Action

- a. COMUSFLTFORCOM will take appropriate action, consistent with reference (a), to establish FLEWEACEN STRIKE DET at Fallon, NV.

b. Master Update Authority, Honolulu, HI will add the PLA in the Central Directory Component via messaging systems effective immediately upon COMUSFLTFORCOM request to Commander, Naval Network Warfare Command (COMNAVNETWARCOM) (Network Operations 321), 112 Lake View Pkwy, Suffolk, VA 23435-2696, via email at C2OIX_Reg@navy.mil or by calling (757) 203-0338/0339. New PLA will be activated via messaging systems. Additional information on naval messaging can be obtained at <https://sailor.nmci.navy.smil.mil> or by contacting COMNAVNETWARCOM at numbers in this subparagraph.

c. Director, Navy Staff, Organization and Management Branch (DNS-33) will add the new detachment to reference (b).

5. Records Management. Records created as a result of this notice, regardless of media or format, must be managed per Secretary of the Navy Manual 5210.1 of January 2012.

6. Cancellation Contingency. This notice will remain in effect for 1 year or until superseded, whichever occurs first. The organization action will remain effective until changed by Director, Navy Staff.
