Subj: ESTABLISHMENT OF ZUMWALT SQUADRON ONE, SAN DIEGO, CA

Ref: (a) OPNAVINST 5400.44A
(b) OPNAVINST 5400.45

1. Purpose. To approve establishment of Zumwalt Squadron One, San Diego, CA to support the new Zumwalt class of destroyers that will be joining the fleet beginning in 2016, per reference (a).

2. Background. Per Navy Strategic Laydown and Dispersal Plan 2015, Commander, Naval Surface Force U.S. Pacific Fleet (COMNAVSURFPAC) will establish Zumwalt Squadron One to support the Navy's next generation of surface combatants, all of which are scheduled to be homeported in San Diego, CA.

3. Organizational Changes. Effective 1 October 2015, establish Zumwalt Squadron One. The following applies:

b. Mission. To serve as the type commander's executive agent and oversee the man, train, maintain, and equip functions for the Zumwalt class of ships; to serve as a supporting commander in a direct support role to provide shore based ship services in the functional areas of engineering, operations, combat systems, supply, and administration; to be the class advocate to articulate requirements, combat capability, and readiness; and to coordinate with provider organizations for products and services in direct support of the ships employment and mission requirements.

c. Budget Submitting Office. Commander, U.S. Pacific Fleet (COMPACFLT).

d. Office of the Chief of Naval Operations (OPNAV) Resource Sponsor. Director, Surface Warfare (OPNAV N96) and Director, Fleet Readiness Division (N43).

e. Area Coordination. Commander, U.S. Fleet Forces Command and Commander, Navy Installations Command.

f. Regional Coordination. Commander, Navy Region Southwest.

g. Administrative Chain of Command

- 1 Chief of Naval Operations
- 2 Commander, U.S. Pacific Fleet (00070)
- 3 Commander, Naval Surface Force, U.S. Pacific Fleet (53824)
- 4 Commander, Zumwalt Squadron One (55770)

4. Action

a. COMPACFLT and COMNAVSURFPAC will take appropriate action, per reference (a), to establish the new command as outlined in paragraph 3. Ensure this operational staff is properly manned, fully trained, and capably equipped to meet the mission requirements listed in this OPNAVNOTE. Issue a mission, functions, and task directive or equivalent instruction that outlines the squadron responsibilities within 90 days of this OPNAVNOTE. Submit a copy to Director, Navy Staff, Organization and Management Branch (DNS-33).

b. Master Update Authority, Honolulu, HI will add the PLA in the Central Directory Component via messaging systems effective immediately upon COMNAVSURFPAC request to Commander, Naval Network Warfare Command (COMNAVNETWARCOM) (Network Operations 321), 112 Lake View Pkwy, Suffolk, VA 23435-2696, via email at C2OIX_Reg@navy.mil or by calling (757) 203-0338/0339. New PLA will be activated via messaging systems. Additional information on naval messaging can be obtained at <https://sailor.nmci.navy.smil.mil> or by contacting COMNAVNETWARCOM at numbers above. (New direction - COMNAVSURFPAC ACTION REQUIRED regarding the PLA).

c. DNS-33 will add the new command to reference (b).

5. Records Management. Records created as a result of this notice, regardless of media or format, must be managed per Secretary of the Navy Manual 5210.1 of January 2012.

6. Cancellation Contingency. This notice will remain in effect for 1 year or until superseded, whichever occurs first. The organization action will remain effective until changed by Director, Navy Staff.
