Subj: CHANGE OF IMMEDIATE SUPERIOR IN COMMAND FOR UNITED STATES SHIP ASHEVILLE, UNITED STATES SHIP JEFFERSON CITY, AND UNITED STATES SHIP SCRANTON

Ref: (a) OPNAVINST 5400.44A
(b) OPNAVINST 5400.45

1. Purpose. To approve change of immediate superior in command (ISIC) for United States Ship (USS) ASHEVILLE (SSN 758), USS JEFFERSON CITY (SSN 759), and USS SCRANTON (SSN 756), per reference (a).

2. Background. The change of ISIC for USS ASHEVILLE and USS JEFFERSON CITY from Submarine Squadron (SUBRON) ELEVEN in San Diego, CA, to SUBRON SEVEN in Pearl Harbor, HI, is necessary as both submarines will remain homeported in Pearl Harbor, HI, after the completion of their respective engineered overhauls. The ISIC change for USS SCRANTON from SUBRON SEVEN in Pearl Harbor, HI, to SUBRON ELEVEN in San Diego, CA, is the result of the decision to homeport USS SCRANTON in San Diego, CA, after the completion of her engineered overhaul in Portsmouth Naval Shipyard rather than returning her to Pearl Harbor, HI. There are no changes to current manpower, funding, or location involved with this modification. All commands involved remain under the command of Commander, U.S. Pacific Fleet.

3. Organizational Changes. Effective immediately for USS SCRANTON, USS ASHEVILLE and USS JEFFERSON CITY, modify ISIC as follows:


4. Action

a. Commander, U.S. Pacific Fleet must take appropriate action to effect the changes in ISIC for the three submarines.

b. Director, Navy Staff Organization and Management Branch (DNS-33) will make the appropriate realignment changes in the next update to reference (b).

5. Records Management. Records created as a result of this notice, regardless of media or format, must be managed per Secretary of the Navy Manual 5210.1 of January 2012.

6. Cancellation Contingency. This notice will remain in effect for 1 year or until superseded, whichever occurs first. The organization action will remain effective until changed by Director, Navy Staff.
