1. Purpose

a. To publish the fiscal year (FY) 2013 to FY 2017 unrestricted line (URL) sequential command, URL major command at sea, URL major command ashore, URL major defense attaché, and restricted line (RL) and Staff Corps major command lists, per reference (a).

b. To establish the membership and responsibilities of the URL Major Command Review Board (MCRB) and RL and Staff Corps MCRB.

c. To publish procedures for submitting change requests to all sequential and major command lists.

2. Background. The designation of URL, RL, and Staff Corps O-6 command billets as sequential command, major command at sea or ashore, or major defense attaché is required to ensure that the most qualified officers are placed in these demanding billets. Officers selected for major command are recognized for their proven managerial and technical expertise, professional qualifications, and exceptional leadership ability.

3. URL MCRB

a. Membership. The URL MCRB shall consist of the following members:

- (1) Office of the Chief of Naval Operations (OPNAV) Director, Military Personnel Plans and Policy Division (N13) (co-chair);
- (2) Commander, Navy Personnel Command (co-chair);
- (3) Director, Expeditionary Warfare Division (OPNAV (N95));
- (4) Director, Surface Warfare Division (OPNAV (N96));
- (5) Director, Submarine Warfare Division (OPNAV (N97));
- (6) Director, Air Warfare Division (OPNAV (N98));
- (7) Commander, Naval Special Warfare Command;
- (8) Commander, Naval Surface Force, U.S. Atlantic Fleet;
- (9) Commander, Naval Air Force, U.S. Atlantic Fleet;
- (10) Commander, Naval Submarine Force, U.S. Pacific Fleet; and
- (11) Deputy Commander, Navy Installations Command.

b. Responsibilities

(1) Review and make recommendations regarding changes to the sequential command, major command at sea or ashore, or major defense attaché lists.

(2) Review and make recommendations regarding the allocation of sequential command, major command at sea or ashore, or major defense attaché billets among the URL and certain RL communities that share or alternate in major command positions with the URL.

(3) Address other sequential and major command-related issues, as appropriate.

(4) Assign a representative to the URL MCRB working group for working-level discussion and actions. The URL MCRB working group is also designated as the command review board and will address O-3, O-4 and O-5 command and O-6 non-major command issues.

(5) Execution of the URL sequential and major command allocation plan is the responsibility of the Assistant Commander, Navy Personnel Command for Distribution (PERS-4). While the desires of sponsors, budget submitting offices (claimants), and type commanders will be taken into consideration by PERS-4 in the allocation plan development and the assignment of screened personnel to major command, PERS-4 is in the best position to consider all factors in making final decisions on the allocation plan.

c. Procedures

(1) The URL MCRB will meet annually, or as directed.

(2) URL MCRB recommendations will be forwarded to the Chief of Naval Personnel for approval.

4. RL and Staff Corps MCRB

a. Membership. The RL and Staff Corps MCRB shall consist of the following members:

- (1) OPNAV (N13) (co-chair);
- (2) Commander, Navy Personnel Command (co-chair);
- (3) Commander, Naval Reserve Forces Command (co-chair);
- (4) Human resources community flag sponsor;
- (5) Engineering duty officer community flag sponsor;
- (6) Chief of Information;

- (7) Foreign area officer community flag sponsor;
- (8) Deputy Director, Navy Medicine (OPNAV (N93B));
- (9) Deputy Judge Advocate General;
- (10) Chief of Supply Corps;
- (11) Chief of Chaplains (CNO (N095));
- (12) Chief of Civil Engineers;
- (13) Information Dominance Corps flag sponsor from 1800, 1810, 1820 or 1830 community, as required;
- (14) Aerospace engineering and aviation maintenance duty officer community flag sponsor; and
- (15) Acquisition Corps community flag sponsor.

b. Responsibilities

- (1) Review and make recommendations regarding changes to the RL and Staff Corps major command list.
- (2) Address other major command-related issues, as appropriate.
- (3) Assign a representative to the RL and Staff Corps MCRB working group for working-level discussion and actions. The RL and Staff Corps MCRB working group is also designated as the command review board and will address O-3, O-4 and O-5 command and O-6 non-major command issues.

c. Procedures

- (1) The RL and Staff Corps MCRB will meet annually, or as directed.
- (2) RL and Staff Corps MCRB recommendations will be forwarded to the Chief of Naval Personnel for approval.

5. Changes to the Major Command Lists

a. Requests for additions to or deletions from the major command lists shall be submitted to OPNAV (N13) via the chain of command no later than 1 March annually. Requests for additions must include the activity name, unit identification code (UIC), and designator of the command billet. In the event Assistant Secretary of the Navy (Research, Development and Acquisition) (ASN (RDA)) adds an acquisition command, a command designation memorandum signed by ASN (RDA) is required. All other requests must also contain justification per the following criteria:

- (1) Number of military personnel assigned;
- (2) Number of civilian personnel assigned;
- (3) Plant replacement costs;
- (4) Total Navy funding levels;
- (5) Nature of the command;
- (6) Magnitude of responsibilities; and
- (7) Significance of actions and decisions

b. Receipt of requests will be acknowledged by OPNAV (N13). Requests will be reviewed at the next appropriate MCRB, and the results will be published via an OPNAV notice.

6. Policy


a. Per reference (a), officers selected for commands listed in enclosures (1) through (5) are required to be qualified and selected by formal board action (i.e., "screened for command") unless waived by the Chief of Naval Personnel. Chief of Naval Personnel is responsible for convening those administrative boards.

b. Changes to the sequential and major command lists are effective immediately upon Chief of Naval Personnel approval.

c. Commander, Navy Personnel Command is responsible to ensure officers detailed to any billet contained in enclosures (1) through (6) possess the correct designator and Navy officer billet code (NOBC) alignment to the billet assigned.

7. Records Management. Records created as a result of this notice, regardless of media and format, shall be managed per Secretary of the Navy Manual 5210.1 of January 2012.

8. Cancellation Contingency. This notice is in effect for 1 year or until superseded, whichever occurs first, and may be retained for reference purposes only.
